Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the blade carriage hoisting capability, there are four sizings of hook type fork carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is approximately thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted forks can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
